28" x 22" poster board – We will bend this in half in class to create a student portfolio. You may bring your poster board to the art room on Orientation Night in August.
Portable container for holding and carrying your supplies – a tackle box works great
<b>Good quality pencil eraser</b> – Magic Rub or Kneaded Rubber by Prismacolor are good brands, but optional
<b>Two or three #2 pencils</b> – Ticonderoga is a good brand. No mechanical pencils please. Students will benefit from having a drawing pencil set of any size, but it is optional.
Set of 8 Crayola broad-line washable markers
Elmer's Glue-All (not Elmer's School Glue) – 7.625 oz or larger
2 glue sticks
Scissors – at least 7 inch in size
Fine-point black Sharpie pen
<b>Sketchbook</b> – preferably 9"x12" or close to that size. The paper needs to be multi-media.
2 ultra-fine-point black pens – either Sharpie or Micron brand
Hand-held pencil sharpener
Watercolor Paints – set of 8 or more. They can be either in tubes or a basic pan set.
3 or more art paintbrushes in various sizes. Some round and some flat; different widths.
12" ruler – non-skid if possible
1 package of 12 or more colored pencils.
Acrylic paint – 2 oz or larger tubes or bottles. One each of red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, black, brown, and 2 of white.

A few other art room items that we can always use if you have them lying around your house: newspaper, pipe cleaners, wire, popsicle sticks, magazines.

\* Please have the items in bold-type by the first day of class. After the first two weeks of school, students should have all of their supplies. Part of the Participation grade is being prepared for class and having the supplies needed. These supplies can be found at most stores like Walmart, Amazon, and Hobby Lobby.
